1. High School Senior Status

Applicants must be high school seniors on track to graduate in the current academic year.

2. Academic Achievement

A minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required, demonstrating a commitment to educational excellence and a strong academic foundation.

3. Community Involvement

Candidates should demonstrate active participation in activities such as leadership roles, community service, sports, school clubs, performing arts, academic competitions, part-time employment, or volunteer work that aligns with the foundation's core values.

4. Essay Requirement

Reflect on the Core Values of the Coach Cornelia Jackson Foundation (listed above). For your essay (500–700 words), choose one of the core values of the Coach Cornelia Jackson Foundation that resonates most with you. In your essay, discuss the following:

- **Personal Connection:** Describe why this core value is significant to you. Share a personal experience or story that highlights your connection to this value.
- **Impact on Life:** Explain how this value has influenced your decisions, actions, or perspective in your life. How has it shaped your character and your interactions with others?

5. Letters of Recommendation

Candidates must submit two (2) letters of recommendation, each including contact information for verification:

- **One letter** from a teacher who can speak about the applicant's academic dedication, work ethic, and integrity.
- **One letter** from a coach, employer, or community leader who can describe the applicant's character, resilience, leadership, and alignment with the foundation's values of compassion and inclusivity.

Note: Each recommender should highlight specific examples of the candidate's strengths, contributions, and impact within the school or community.

- 1. Review Eligibility Criteria**

- An unofficial copy of your high school transcript.

Combine all materials into one PDF file and submit via email to info@cjacksonfoundation.org. Ensure that your application is submitted by the deadline.

- 5. Check for Confirmation**
